**World Day of the Poor** Pope Francis established the World Day of the Poor in 2017. The Holy Father's message for 2020 is a reflection on Sirach 7:32: **"Stretch forth your hand to the poor"**. As Catholics we should make this a time of action in response to Christ's words from the Gospel of Matthew: **"whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me"** (Mt. 25:40). This could include donating food to your Parish or community foodbank, safely passing on some homegrown vegetables to a neighbour, baking a cake for a newborn's family or sharing a meal with others. **'Prayer attains its goal when accompanied by service to the poor.'** Pope Francis: Message for the Fourth World Day of the Poor, 15 November 2020.

### **Reflections on today's reading**



*His master said to him in reply, 'You wicked, lazy servant! So, you knew that I harvest where I did not plant and gather where I did not scatter? Should you not then have put my money in the bank so that I*

*could have got it back with interest on my return? Now then! Take the talent from him and give it to the one with ten.' For to everyone who has, more will be given and he will grow rich; but from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away (Matt 25:26-29).* For the followers of Christ who are sincere in their efforts, the parable has a message of encouragement and consolation. At times the road we have to travel seems strewn with obstacles, our battles seem never-ending, yet God has provided each one of us with the necessary helps to ensure the final victory. Those servants in the parable who received five and two talents used them faithfully and successfully. He who received one talent needed only one, and could have succeeded with it had he been a faithful servant. Eternal happiness is the divine reward for an earthly service faithfully rendered. God is a kind Father who has our eternal interests at heart. He does expect us to make the necessary sacrifices. He showed us the way on Calvary. When working for God we are really providing for our own future; his external glory

and our eternal salvation are the fruits of the same labor. He will certainly return to settle accounts – it will then be too late to make any changes. Let us be wise and make the changes now while we have time and then our books will be in order on the day of reckoning. Let us pray ***Grant us, we pray, O Lord our God, the constant gladness of being devoted to you, for it is full and lasting happiness to serve with constancy the author of all that is good. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.***
